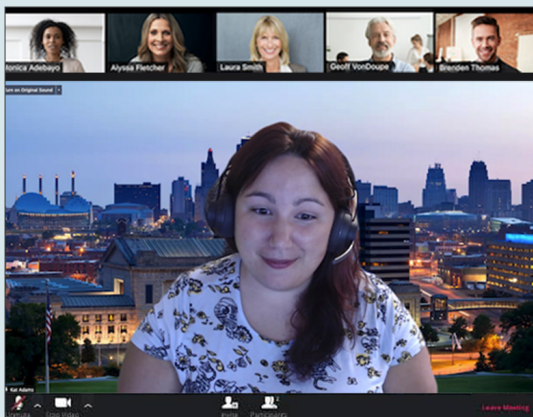

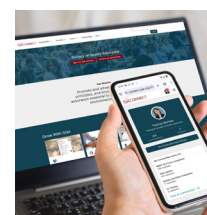

Active Members — Join for One or Two Years

- Eligible to run for election as Officers, Directors, and Elected Committee members
- Entitled to vote in elections and on other matters pertaining to the affairs of the Society
- Requirements: Completed membership application and payment of Active Member dues of \$215

Outreach Members

- Individuals who reside in a low/middle income country as defined by the World Bank and demonstrate active professional involvement in research/regulatory quality assurance
- One-time application fee of \$15 with complimentary membership
- Requirements: Completed membership application and annual submission of current résumé or CV

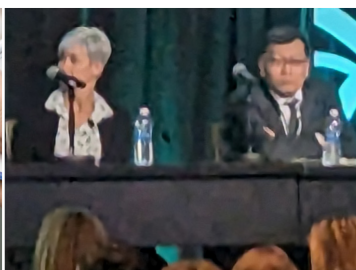
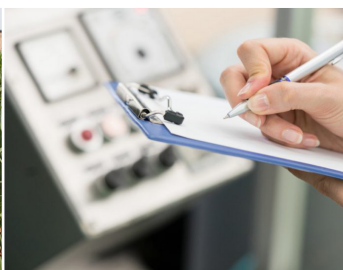
